

INNOCHANGE APPROACH & VISION (1/3)



Develop and improve the entrepreneurial education curriculum and associated teacher training

Enabling the provision of continuing entrepreneurial education and equipping HEI staff and students to commence the innovation and entrepreneurship pathway -> Significantly advance the capacities of partner HEIs in the field of innovation and entrepreneurship





INNOCHANGE APPROACH & VISION (2/3)



Support HEIs internal innovation efforts & introduce new innovation management model (Innovation Task Force), support early-stage innovation projects

Involvement of students with entrepreneurial knowledge & skills in innovation management processes -> Institutional change in partner HEIs & bridging the gap of the theoretical and practical results by bringing technology to the market





INNOCHANGE APPROACH & VISION (3/3)



Nurture technical digital innovation, support entrepreneurship communities at HEIs (Student Entrepreneurship Digital Hub, Digital Practitioners' Hub) and build out industry partnerships

Enabling a mature innovation culture in transforming ideas to products -> Empowering InnoChange HEIs to become engines of impact and reinforcing the knowledge triangle





INNOCHANGE EXCELLENCE



- ✓ Regional outreach of the project to the **Regional Innovation Scheme (RIS) modest** innovation regions and enhance their access to the EIT KICs (Digital, Food, Health etc.) and support the entrepreneurial transformation of HEIs in the CEE region
- ✓ Involving faculties from the Computer Science domains-> The consortium has a strong basis/grounding/roots in Computer Science and Information Technologies. -> Digital technologies and digital transformation could serve as a common driving and supporting tool to build collaboration with other KICs and industrial partners
- ✓ The partners' complementary expertise creates a solid foundation for the implementation of the Knowledge triangle-based innovation education, already during the first 6 months InnoChange will:
 - impact 130 students, 12 academic-, 12 non-academic staff and 2 start-ups
 - create Innovation Task Force, Student Entrepreneurship Digital Hub









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
